DECISIONS...DECISIONS...

Some women attribute THEIR bad decisions to the man they *chose*.

In other words, the man is not what he pretended to be, or he “changed” on them in some way. The bottom line is that women who choose to lay the blame for *their* bad decisions on the man...are doomed to repeat the same process with yet another “horrible man.”

The best way I can put this is, there are lions and tigers and bears in every zoo. As you walk through the zoo of life and choose to crawl into the cage with a lion, tiger or bear, because it looks “fun,” then whom can you blame when you are mauled? Certainly, you cannot blame the lion, tiger or bear for being animals. After all, they are what they are.

The same can be said of men. There are a wide variety of different types of men in the world, in this society, and in your environment. Not all of them are docile creatures, and not all will meet your requirements for love. The good news is that you get to choose the men you wish to spend time with, and ultimately the man you wish to marry.

The bad news is that without a good method of choosing, you can wind up taking home a cuddly koala bear that will rip your heart out.

Well, after all...it is a bear. No matter how cute and cuddly.

STUDYING MEN CAN BE FUN

A woman should not force herself to believe a man is what *she* wants him to be. She should study him, as if she were choosing her wedding ring. Look for his flaws. Check him out under the microscope of scrutiny. Project 5, 10, 15 and 20 years into the future, thinking what life will be like with this man.

Will he still retain the same value? Will his value increase or decrease over time?

Question him. Propose scenarios and check his answers. Find out who and *what* you are dealing with. But of course, all of this seemingly cannot be done in the course of one date, or even several...but rather must be done over the course of a long time period.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE...AND THE WAY TO AVOID DISASTER

Unfortunately, many women are impatient, easily emotionally enthralled, and physically incapable of keeping their legs closed and their virtue intact when a man raises their blood pressure each time they are in his presence.

That problem doesn't lie with man...it lies with you.

If you choose to give your heart, mind and body to a lion while pretending it's a domestic cat, when it rips your heart out, it's too late to think you should've made a better choice. Your heart is torn, your perception shattered and likely you've lost your innocence, your virtue, and many other things that were among the attributes most valuable to your spirit.

After such devastation in one's life, it would seem that any woman would be smarter with the next choice. But that isn't logical at all.

THE KEY TO MAKING BAD CHOICES, OVER AND OVER...

The reason many Christian women fall to such destructive choices is due to a lack of information on HOW TO MAKE GOOD CHOICES.

So, the logical result of their next choice will be similar to the first one, thus creating a pattern others can easily recognize, while the woman remains in the dark until someone comes along and points it out. Even if she was to recognize it herself, or someone pointed it out, what can she do when there is NO SPECIFIC METHOD in choosing a perfect mate for *her*?

It is both embarrassing and shameful to have someone point out your ignorance. It is also tough to acknowledge such ignorance in oneself, especially when we think of

ourselves as highly evolved, intelligent and perceptive people.

THE **M**ENTAL ASPECT OF CHOOSING MEN

In choosing a man, many women use a completely different mindset than the one they use to advance in their educational and career goals.

It may be useful for women seeking suitable mates to view the world from the perspective of a spiritual battleground. There are forces that support God and advance God's Will, or agenda. And there are forces that support Satan and advance an evil agenda.

The agenda of Satan is virtually unrecognizable by those who have distance in their relationship with God. This is a key point. And, it is an unfortunate reality that too often women and children become spiritual casualties in this war because of the poor choices Christian women make in choosing a mate.

If Jesus is the head of the church and man is the head of the woman, it would seem logical that a woman would choose a man (as her head/leader) who chooses Jesus as the authority in his life.

Ephesians 5:23 - For the husband is the **head** of the wife, even as Christ is the **head** of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

But when a woman chooses a man, even if only for a temporary fling or physical and emotional affair, she is subject to the consequences of that choice, which also includes bearing children or bearing the scars of that relationship...however short or long it may have been.

FALLING PREY TO SENSUAL DEMONS OF LUST

Can you imagine bearing children for a *demon*?

Upon this spiritual battleground we call earth, there are men who have chosen to follow the agenda of evil. This agenda is seemingly wonderful, fun, adventuresome, pleasurable and exciting. It is a terrific enticement to both men and women. Men find it alluring because it enables them to pursue their own desires and pleasures, while women quite often desire the men...who have made a conscious decision to follow Satan.

Of course, not all men who are indulging in their lusts have decided to forsake God altogether. Some are going through short phases, while others may return to God at some point later in life. However, there are consequences nonetheless for disobedience...and women who pursue men who are pursuing passions forbidden by God all too often find themselves impacted heavily by *their* choices of those men.

So how can a woman determine if a guy is going through a phase out of which he will return to serving God and our Savior Lord Jesus Christ?

She cannot. Indulging in men who have forsaken their relationship with God is a pursuit from which few women will escape unscathed, however short and temporary their engagement with these men may be. And the consequences for women are unfortunately typically far more devastating than the consequences for the men they choose.

FINDING THE RIGHT GUY “FOR ME”

There is no foolproof method of finding and attracting the perfect man for each woman, and then securing a relationship with him. But the insights provided in this book will enable women to avoid many of the pitfalls most women fall into, simply because they are ignorant of the characteristics they should seek to find in a man.

Keep in mind that if you have to ask, “Is this man going through a phase right now, from which he will emerge to serve Christ?” The question itself is your clue to keep your distance from this man. Your choice of a mate should come solely from a pool of candidates that are already serving God...if you wish to avoid the catastrophes that accompany the lives of those who are complacent while indulging in sin.

THE BEAUTY OF SIN

Still, many women adore evil characteristics in men. Yet they do not necessarily know these are *evil* characteristics. Most people think of evil as something one can easily recognize, as in the movies where the killer actually LOOKS like he's a killer.

In Hollywood movies, Dracula, the blood-sucking vampire, is made to be alluring to women. He is handsome, smooth talking, with a virile nature and sexual appetite. He makes the women desire to give themselves over to him...and their own passions. This is not too far-fetched from what happens when women fawn over evil men.

In real life, women are drawn into relationships with potential murderers, rapists, child molesters, illegal drug dealers and addicts, addictive personalities, alcoholics, etc. Many, if not all, of these men can be weeded out before a woman loses control of her senses, her mind, her heart...and her body.

“IT JUST FEELS RIGHT”

It is unfortunate that women are not taught definitively how to choose men, and therefore employ a variety of methods based upon what they *feel* is right and what their friends may advise. Typically mom is of no use in teaching her daughter how to choose men because she has no idea

how she ended up with the man she has...whether or not he is evil or a follower of God.

IT'S ALL MY FAULT?

Society is a reflection of an overwhelming number of women making terrible choices because they have never been taught how to choose. And unfortunately, the consequences of women making bad choices are far greater than the consequences of men's bad choices in women.

It may seem a bit presumptuous to lay all the responsibility at the foot of a woman. But then again, when a woman is left holding the bag, with a broken heart, pregnant and alone...only one person has the ability to change the process...it is that woman.

WHAT IS THE BEST METHOD OF FINDING A GOOD GUY?

Therefore, this book is not about changing men, but rather it is about offering women the CHOICE to employ a method of choosing men that works!

It is the *methodology*, or lack thereof, in choosing a mate that hampers so many women in finding good men.

Therefore, this book addresses the process by providing women an insight into what they should look for in men

that will greatly improve their chances of finding a mate who is appropriate and wonderful for their lives.

A WORD OF CAUTION...

No man-made process is foolproof. And no foolproof process employed by humans (who make mistakes) is infallible. Therefore, this process of finding the right mate for you is merely a *guide* that will provide insights into the character of the men with whom you come into contact.

IT IS STILL YOUR CHOICE...

There is no accounting for the lies women tell themselves in order to gain access to a sexual involvement with a man. Do not blame this method if it fails you in this regard, because the number one rule is to remain obedient to God's Will...not your own.

Many women seek refuge in the arms of men. Some seek sexual release and pleasure. Some also seek direction for their lives. But in most cases, they tell themselves it is "LOVE" they seek.

THE SEARCH FOR LOVE

In so many cases of seeking "love," women settle for "boyfriends" instead of "husbands."

Regardless of the reasons a woman seeks out a man, anytime she settles to *act* in the role of a wife for a man to

whom she isn't married, or for a man to whom she isn't engaged to be married...she is in trouble.

MY BOYFRIEND LOVES ME!

Whenever I hear the words, "my boyfriend," I listen intently for the description of the relationship. It is typically an *intimate* relationship where the woman has been influenced to believe there is a commitment of some sort involved. It is a relationship that the woman engages in because she thinks it is similar to marriage, in that she believes there is some sort of commitment.

THE PROVERBIAL BRICK OVER THE HEAD!

However, ONE question can serve to jolt her from her trance-like state (if only for a second before she readily resumes it... unfortunately). The question is:

"For how long?"

For how long is this man your "boyfriend?" 10 weeks?
10 years?

When the boyfriend/girlfriend relationship was established, what length of time was stated as the goal for the relationship?

TOUGH QUESTIONS

What has given the woman the impression there is a commitment for *any* length of time?

Some women surmise that since they have been sexually active with “*my man*,” he is OBLIGATED to be sexually active only with her. Or he may indicate in some way that this is his intent. And what exactly obligates him? A half-hearted statement that *has no time frame*?

Of course, he never says FOR HOW LONG he will continue this behavior....

And she NEVER asks.

This is what passes for commitment today?

Unfortunately, yes.

SO WHAT IS A COMMITMENT?

A true commitment always contains a time frame and parameters or boundaries.

God’s commitment to mankind is from the beginning of life to the end of our lives (in heaven there is no end to life). That is a time frame.

God places boundaries on that commitment as well, to ensure that we know it is a commitment to His children that believe in Him and strive to be obedient, not a commitment to every soul on earth. God has enemies here too (keep in mind that even angels were tossed out of heaven who went to war with God).

Parents who love their children are committed to them for life. Yet again, we see the time frame factor involved in true commitments. It is not simply an emotion that parents *feel*. Many emotions will come and go, as emotions do. These feelings are temporary and fluid.... and are transitional.

LOVE (COMMITMENT) IS NOT AN EMOTION

Love is the stable foundation upon which everything else is built in a relationship. Anger, joy, disappointment, elation, sadness, jealousy, hatred...are all feelings, which have a place within the spectrum of human emotions. But none of these are cause for the replacement or removal of the foundation of commitment.... which is what we see over the course of time, and what we can describe simply as “love.”

God’s love for us has a time frame, which is forever. Our parents’ love for us has a time frame, which is for life. A man’s love for a woman *has* to have a time frame...or there is no love (commitment).

Where there is love there is commitment. They are one and the same. And commitments have time frames...and boundaries...and sacrifices.

In marriage the time frame is “until death” and the boundaries are “in sickness and health, richer or poorer” etc.

Of course, exceptions in a woman's commitment to a man (and vice versa) are made for those whose spouses step outside of the boundaries, such as consistent unrepentant adultery, child abuses, extreme violence, rape, murder, etc. No woman is bound by commitment (love) to any man who subjects her and her children to such evil.

TRUE COMMITMENTS CONTAIN TIME AND BOUNDARIES

The point is that both a time frame and a boundary must be present in a true commitment. And commitments often manifest themselves through sacrifices...as God's commitment to mankind manifested itself in the supreme sacrifice of His only begotten Son...for *our* salvation. But before the manifestation of sacrifices in a relationship, the immediate clues to love employ the declaration of both a time frame and a set of boundaries.

THE BOYFRIEND/GIRLFRIEND PHENOMENA

Neither time frames nor specific boundaries are ever present in the proverbial "girlfriend/boyfriend" juvenile relationships. These relationships are considered *juvenile* regardless of the age of the participants...because the relationship itself is immature. Even the name of the relationship is born of juvenile thought processes. The "couple" is not married. They are *not* husband and wife. And because they're *not* engaged to be married, they aren't fiancées either. So what *are* they?

WE'RE JUST FRIENDS

The term “friends” has received a bad name over the evolution of society in the past few decades. There seems to be a marked difference between “we’re friends” and we’re *just* friends.” Nobody wants to be “just” friends.

So what does everyone want to be, if not friends, and not married?

There is no legitimate name for any other relationship between men and women outside of marriage and engagement other than the term “friends.”

The old NBC situation comedy “Friends” illustrates this point through comedic plots and circumstances. The writers at one point had the characters Ross and Rachel arguing over the point of whether or not they were, “on a break” in their “relationship.” The only difference in their relationship as friends and their “relationship” (as they dubbed it) was the fact that they had sex. It changed the nature of their relationship and they failed to find anything they could call it other than a “relationship.” Given there was no time frame for their “relationship” the humor surrounds the silliness involved in being “on a break.” Additionally, they, like so many of us, fail to find a suitable term for sexual relationships where there is no marriage, and no engagement and date for a marriage.

So, the term “boy” and “girl” is added onto the term “friend” to signify these two friends have agreed to have an intimate relationship with each other. But again...for how long?

The boyfriend/girlfriend relationship is not only acceptable throughout our society as the NORMAL method of engaging in relationships between men and women (and boys and girls), but it is condoned and actually promoted by parents...even many Christian parents!

UM, DAD...GUESS WHAT? I’VE GOT A GIRLFRIEND

Can you imagine how *I* reacted when my 15-year-old son told me that he had a *girlfriend*? Here is a paraphrased re-creation of the actual conversation I had with my son many years ago.

“Hmmm...so you have a girlfriend now?”

“Yes, dad! She’s great.”

“I see. And is her father aware that you have decided to be sexually intimate with his daughter?”

“What do you mean dad?”

“Well son. Let’s not buy into the societal pretense that allows for children to pretend they are married while adults look the other way. You have stated that this is now your ‘GIRL’ friend, signifying there is something *different* in

your relationship than if you and she were just friends. Can you tell me what is different?”

“I don’t understand dad.”

“Yes, you do son. You may not wish to divulge that you and this friend will now hold hands, giggle at one another, hug and kiss passionately and employ actions and activities that involve lust and pursuits of sexual pleasures...but surely you are instinctively aware that the difference in your relationship is that you both have a mutual understanding that intimacy is now allowed between you. My question is merely have you informed her father that you intend to put your tongue into the mouth of his daughter?”

“Dad! Why do you have to make things sound like they are bad?”

“Son, I never said it was bad for you to have sex with this girl outside of marriage. I never said it was bad for a 15-year-old and a 14-year-old to make out and give in to their sexual hormones. I never said it was bad for you to engage in the intimacy you and she surely plan to engage in. I simply asked if you had informed her father of your plans?”

“Uh...no dad.”

“Well, why not? This is a glorious occasion, is it not? You were happy to announce to me that you plan to engage in sexual relations with this child for an unspecified period of time. You were all too content to continue engaging in intimate relations with this child until you decided you had had enough...or she decided she had had enough...or she became pregnant...or gave you a disease...or some unforeseen occurrence came along and precipitated your breakup. So, why are you not happily informing *her* father of this great decision you and she have made?”

“I didn’t say all of that, Dad, but I see your point.”

“Are ya sure son? Because it isn’t MY point. It was given to us all by our Father in heaven. And since He wrote it down and handed it to us and saw to it that throughout the centuries and the efforts to destroy the writings of His Word, they were preserved nevertheless. So, having this *instruction book*, you chose to ignore it, and on your own made a decision to get sexually involved with a young girl?”

“Dad...we’re not sexually involved?”

“Oh. Then I apologize son.”

“It’s okay dad.”

“So, tell me...what were your intentions with this ‘*girlfriend*?’”

“Dad!”

“Son...you called her a girlfriend, not me. Had you simply said I have a new friend, our conversation would have been completely different.”

“But just because she’s my girlfriend doesn’t mean we are having sex.”

“Good point, son. So, tell me...what DOES having a girlfriend mean?”

“Dad...(sigh). Fine. It means she and I will go out together and hang out. Stuff like that.”

“I see. And where will you go...being just 14 and 15 years old?”

“I don’t know Dad...out. Just out.”

“Sorry son. Never been there. Is ‘OUT’ a specific place or is that just a term you use to dissuade adults from asking too many questions about your so-called personal business?”

“Okay dad. We’re not boyfriend and girlfriend. We won’t go out.”

“I appreciate the assurance son. But I wasn’t aware that it was within your power to make those decisions anyway. I understand you are growing up. But that doesn’t

eliminate my responsibilities as your father to ensure you are provided the guidance your Father in heaven has specified applies to us all. You won't go out without adult supervision. That is to discourage you and she from acting on the very same impulses that caused you and her to think of yourselves as a 'couple' rather than friends."

"Dad, I told you we would not have sex."

"Son, you don't have complete control over your hormones, and your behavior *can* be impacted by the powerful urges of your body chemistry. You may assume you won't have sex. But you **WILL** choose to be intimate. There is no other reason for the title of BOYFRIEND and GIRLFRIEND. It is a title placed upon a relationship where two people have decided they will be intimate with one another for an unspecified period of time. And if you choose to do this, my advice is to tell her dad the good news. Shall I call him?"

"No dad."

"Why not?"

"Because it is wrong."

"What is wrong, son?"

"Being intimate with someone. Having sex with someone when you're not married."

“Why is it wrong, son? Because you can catch disease? You can always wear a condom, you know. Is it wrong because you can get her pregnant? She can get birth control pills and you can wear a condom too. Is it wrong because you might break her heart...or she might break yours? Well, that’s the breaks of taking such a risk on an intimate relationship with an unspecified time period.”

“No dad. It’s not wrong because of any of that.”

“Then I am not sure I understand, son. Why is the boyfriend/girlfriend relationship wrong?”

“Because God said it was wrong.”

“Hmmm...God said it, huh? Hmmm...so why does God disapprove of sex outside of marriage?”

“For all the reasons you stated dad.”

“But there are preventions for all the reasons I stated. And God STILL disapproves?”

“Yeah dad. Is this going anywhere?”

“Well, yes son. It *is* going somewhere. You see, we cannot fathom the many consequences inherent in disobeying God. When we incorporate these pretenses in our lives in order to allow our minds to believe we are okay in the eyes of God because our relationships have titles, we open up a world of problems that society has to

deal with. And not only society...but we as individuals make terrible choices when we follow our emotional impulses and indulge in our own passions and those choices have consequences that can impact our lives and the lives of children of future generations...not to mention the enormous impact on our spirit.”

“What do you mean, dad?”

“It’s like this son. If you and that little girl defy your parents and decide to go ahead and indulge in your passions...and she gets pregnant. Then what do you do?”

“I don’t know dad. It won’t happen.”

“Right son. The answer is you don’t know. But I do...and so does God. That child is born to two unmarried parents. Neither of which have the knowledge of how to teach that child to be what God wants the child to be. Of course, society thinks about the problems associated with raising the child, such as food, clothing, shelter, etc. But the *real* problem is not where all of those needs will come from, but rather how the child will be impacted without the guidance and love and leadership of two married, committed parents who love God and incorporate those boundaries into their lives and the lives of their children.

“In other words, not only will the child likely be born in poverty, exposed to much of the negatives of our society, but the child will also be exceptionally vulnerable to evil

influences into which he or she will be completely immersed on a daily basis. Seldom do we think of the big picture.... which is the battle between God and evil for the salvation of our souls.

“How will you help save your child from evil when you aren’t there? How will the child’s mom save her child when she is living outside of God’s boundaries? Children recognize our hypocrisy as adults and they do not respect it. And that’s one of the reasons why we have so many problems with children when we live outside of God’s boundaries. We subject them to evil, which they then throw in our face. Don’t you know Satan knows our weaknesses and our sins? And don’t you know that when our children toss our sins in our face, they are being influenced by Satan to do so? This is a parent’s clue that they are engaged in a spiritual war for the soul of their child. How would you as an absent father deal with such a battle?”

“Okay dad. So what should I do?”

“That’s the question I have been waiting on, son. *You* should be obedient to your Father(s). The One in heaven and the one in this house. And by being obedient, you will grow up with the character of a Godly man. And when women see that character, they will clamor for your attention. You will not lack for attention from women. However, you must maintain your character despite what they will offer. It is all too easy to take advantage of women

because they offer so much and ask for so little. Your desire should be to please your Father. In doing so, not only will the perfect mate for you come along, but you will avoid the pitfalls and traps of falling for women who make bad decisions and then blame their pitiful plight in life on the men they've come across."

"I still don't know what to do, Dad."

"I am proud of what you have already done, son. You have decided to be obedient to your Fathers. And because of that, there are tremendous blessings in store for you down the road."

"How do you know I have made that decision, Dad?"

"Because you asked the question... 'what should I do?' That is the first step, son. Discovering what is expected of you...and then following the path laid before you."

"But what about my um...*friend*, Dad?"

"The two of you can still be friends...just not *intimate* friends. Son, she, like millions of young girls and women in this country, will have to learn also to be obedient. And in doing so they will be rewarded as well, with someone who fits them and is perfect for them. That may be *you*...who knows?"

"How will they know who that person is, Dad?"

“He will have the character of a Godly man.”

“What is that, Dad?”

“It is what I am instilling in you, with God’s help.”

“The character of God?”

“Absolutely! There are seven primary characteristics of a Godly man, son.”

“And I suppose you are going to tell me what they are...right Dad?”

“Actually, son...I am going to write them in a book and tell women across the country what these characteristics are. It is they who need this information more than you.”
